

Dear Parish Councillors,

We forward the questions raised at the recent Parish Council meeting as requested.

One of our issues remain with the Parish Council's role in this matter: are the Parish Council involved in the Map Modification Application or are they not, if they are involved then to what extent?

The response states that "the Parish Council has at no time commissioned and issued a questionnaire relating to the road from Pitchford to Golding". This is most definitely incorrect and we would like to know why the Parish Council say they have not been involved?

We are also confused as to how much assistance the Parish Council is giving the applicant, would you please clarify?

We think there has been a misunderstanding about our comment on Councillors declaring an interest. Councillor Johnson rode along our Driveway, so therefor had an interest that should, in our opinion, have been declared?
